About the Program

MANAGE- Centre for Innovation and Agripreneurship (CIA) is a Centre of Excellence in Agribusiness Incubation hosted at the National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE). It is one of the leading Agribusiness Incubators in India with incubated 495 and mentored 989 Agripreneurs & startups from various focus areas of the Agri & Allied Sectors.

Having trained start-ups from agro-processing, post-harvest technologies, value addition, farm mechanization, animal husbandry, fisheries, dairy, commodity trading to supply chain management and Agri-Consultancy, the Centre has assisted and provided relentless support to Agripreneurs, helping them fine tune their ideas and upscale their operations.

With each graduating cohort, it came to the centre's notice that though there are enthusiastic budding Agripreneurs willing to invest time and money, yet they lack apt mentoring platforms to sharpen/refine their ideas & provide necessary connectivity & guidance on various aspects of agribusiness. This gap was acting as a big chasm for people with business ideas to venture any further into the Agri-ecosystem.

Taking cognizance of this gap and recounting all experiences/feedback from previous five cohort's MANAGE-CIA decided to come up with a one of its kind Pre-Incubation training programs to assist anyone with a business idea interested to work in Agri-ecosystem, to guide them in idea generation, understanding the Agri startup ecosystem and setting up the business. With the boom in the Agri-tech sector and more getting into entrepreneurship, foundation programs like pre-incubation programs will help to set them on the right path.

Objectives of the Program

f.

- To Facilitate creative and strategic idea generation among aspiring agripreneurs, encouraging the development of impactful and sustainable solutions for the agricultural sector.
- To Assist participants in refining their business ideas by providing expert insights, practical frameworks, and personalized feedback aligned with the unique dynamics of the agri-startup ecosystem.
- To Equip participants with essential knowledge, skills, and resources to confidently navigate their entrepreneurial journey—covering key aspects such as business model development, market validation, value proposition, and funding pathways.



Eligible Participants of the Program

The 8th Pre-Incubation Mentoring Program was open to Agri-startups, aspiring entrepreneurs at the idea or pre-idea stage, students and youth interested in agripreneurship, professionals working in the agri-startup ecosystem, agricultural extension professionals, and anyone with an interest in starting an agri-startup.

Structure and Overview of the Program

The 8th Pre-Incubation Mentoring Program was a 22-day capacity-building training initiative designed for aspiring agripreneurs and startups. The program included 30 hours of sessions conducted over 15 days, followed by a week of one-on-one handholding and mentoring. It commenced on March 18, 2025, and concluded on April 8, 2025.

During the program, MANAGE-CIA conducted 33 insightful sessions, including experience-sharing interactions with incubated agri-startups and One-on-One Mentoring sessions. Additionally, five one-on-one mentoring sessions were held, allowing each participant to choose up to three experts from the pool of resource persons for personalized discussions regarding their ideas, queries, or startup plans.

The program covered all major aspects of agribusiness, offering participants a comprehensive understanding of the agri-startup ecosystem and effective strategies for scaling their ventures. It was a one-of-its-kind paid online program, with a registration fee of ₹5,000 for Indian participants and \$60 for international participants.

The initiative successfully enabled agripreneurs to progress from the idea stage to the MVP (Minimum Viable Product) stage, while enhancing their understanding of business development, key entrepreneurial skills, challenges, and emerging opportunities in the agri sector.

The Pre-Incubation Mentoring Program aims to enhance the entrepreneurial capabilities of aspiring agripreneurs and create greater awareness about Agri Startups.

The program offers a comprehensive understanding of the startup ecosystem, covering key aspects such as business model development, skill building, opportunity mapping, and tackling entrepreneurial challenges. With agriculture being a core sector of the Indian economy, the initiative supports the vision of developing India as a hub for agripreneurship by bridging knowledge gaps and creating a forward-looking approach to building successful ventures.

Sessions delivered by experienced professionals and the MANAGE-CIA team, the program boosts participant confidence and expands their existing knowledge.


Inaugural Session

The inaugural session of the program was held on **18th March 2025** and was graced by **Dr. Saravanan Raj**, Director (Agricultural Extension), MANAGE & CEO, MANAGE – Centre for Innovation and Agripreneurship (CIA). He formally inaugurated the program and delivered the **inaugural address**, warmly welcoming all participants and emphasizing the importance of



such initiatives in nurturing early-stage agripreneurs.

Following the inaugural address, **Mr. Arvind Singh**, Intern at MANAGE-CIA, shared an overview of the program's journey, highlighting the successful completion of the previous seven batches of the program and the impact created so far.



The session also included participant introductions, during which attendees shared their backgrounds, the kind of support they were seeking, and their expectations from the program. The interactive session helped set a collaborative tone for the program and facilitated initial networking among the participants.

Mentoring Sessions

Session 1. Unlocking Government Support & Funding Avenues for Agri-Startups

Speaker- Ms. V. Usha Sree, Manager (RKVY-RAFTAAR)

Ms. V. Usha Sree delivered an engaging and informative session on the RKVY-RAFTAAR project initiated by the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Government of India. She elaborated on its key incubation schemes—Student Orientation Program, Agripreneurship Orientation Programme, and Startup Agribusiness Incubation Programme—

oriented schemes such as Agri-Clinics & Agri-Business Centres (AC&ABC), Agri Infrastructure Fund, and Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana, along with opportunities under BIRAC, Ministry of Science & Technology, the Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, and Atal Innovation Mission. The session concluded with an interactive discussion, where participants actively engaged with the



speaker and received insightful responses to their queries.

Session 2. Agri-Startups in "Urban Farming"

Speaker- Mr. Anil Konduti, Founder, Vrukshakuteeram LLP

Mr. Anil Konduti shared the story of his startup, which integrates agriculture

and allied services into landscape gardening. His company provides comprehensive solutions including design, execution, maintenance, and farm consultancy. During the session, he discussed the challenges he encountered throughout his entrepreneurial journey, such as market competition and resource management, and how he successfully overcame these obstacles.



Session 3. Decoding the Agri-Startups Ecosystem: The Role of Incubators

Mr. Amit Kale conducted a thoughtprovoking session focused on providing participants with a comprehensive understanding of the startup ecosystem, with a special focus on the critical role incubators play in supporting agristartups. He explained the concept of a startup entity, delved into the global and Indian startup landscapes, and highlighted top-performing states, union territories, and major startup hubs



in India. He also discussed various state-specific agri-startup initiatives.

Her experience offered valuable insights into product innovation, market positioning, and perseverance, leaving participants motivated to pursue their own entrepreneurial goals in the agri-food sector.




Her expertise provided valuable perspectives on grassroots innovation, motivating participants to explore meaningful solutions within the agri-biotech industry.

Session 15. Blueprinting Resilient Ventures: Crafting a Robust Business Plan


Speaker- Mr. Pradeep Kulkarni, Consultant Trainer

One-on-One Mentoring Sessions

In the final week of the program, each participant was given the opportunity to choose up to three experts—from among those who conducted sessions during the first 15 days—for a personal one-on-one discussion. These sessions were designed to provide personalized mentoring and guidance tailored to the participants' startup ideas, challenges, or any queries related to their entrepreneurial journey or the program.

Each participant could interact with a selected expert for a maximum of 60 minutes. During these sessions, participants shared details about their startup concepts, discussed specific problems they were facing, and sought expert advice. In return, they received valuable guidance, suggestions, and mentoring from the experts.

Although the program had 20 participants, a total of 29 mentoring slots were utilized, as some participants opted to meet with two or three experts. In total, five experts conducted the one-on-one mentoring sessions, resulting in a rich and impactful conclusion to the program.


