

I also gained clarity on research methodologies, including different scales and measurements vital for academic work.

Dr. Rasheed Sulaiman's session on policy engagement highlighted the critical role of extension professionals in policymaking. His impactful delivery style left a lasting impression. Dr. Ramanjaneyulu opened our eyes to the future of agriculture through his talk on Ecological Farming and emphasized the evolving responsibilities of extension professionals.



A visit to Access Livelihoods helped us understand NGO functioning at the grassroots, particularly in mobilizing communities for sustainable, community-based agriculture.





One of the most empowering sessions was on the use of AI tools for academic research.
