Feed The Future India Triangular Training (FTF ITT) is a collaborative program of United States of America represented by USAID, India and Government of India represented by National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE). FTF ITT aims at building the capacity of Public and Private Functionaries in Agriculture and Allied sectors of 17 Partner Asian and African Countries in emerging areas of Agriculture Development relevant to their respective countries. The relevancy was identified and prioritized based on Demand Analysis carried out by MANAGE.



Partner Countries

African Countries - Botswana, DR Congo, Ghana, Kenya, Liberia, Malawi, Mozambique, Rwanda, Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda.

Partner Institutions are identified and selected based on their expertise, experience,

infrastructure facilities available etc. MANAGE partner with National organizations, International Organizations, Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) Institutions, State

Asian Countries - Afghanistan, Cambodia, Lao PDR, Mongolia, Myanmar and Vietnam.

A minimum of 1,400 executives will be trained over the four year life of the project i.e. 2016-20.



In-Country Programs - Thirty two 15 days duration training programs will be conducted in India for Executives of 17 Partner Countries.

Third Country Programs - Twelve 10 days duration training programs will be conducted in selected African and Asian countries.



The training sessions will be delivered through lectures, group discussions, case studies and field visits. Training is highly participatory, each participant is expected to contribute ideas and take part in group activities. The participants will work in small groups to undertake various tasks allotted to them. Experiential learning methodology is effectively incorporated in the program. Apart from their past experience, the participants would learn through group interaction, from experiences in the field and from interaction with industry experts and the trainers. Before and after tests are conducted to understand the impact of training on the knowledge of executives.


