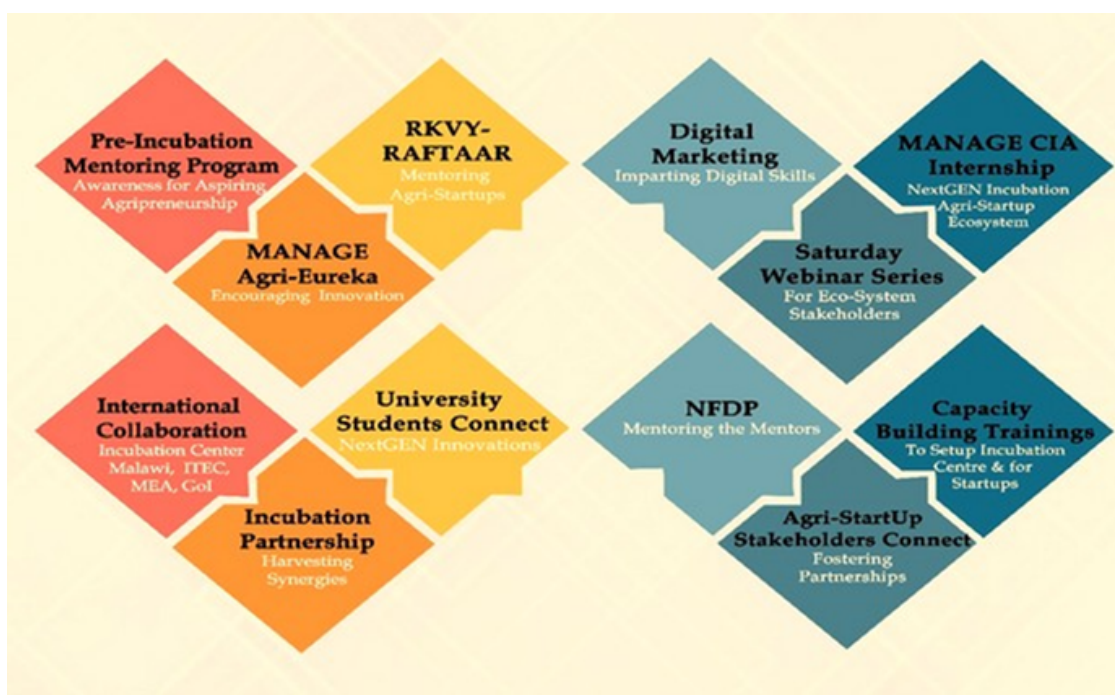

The Centre supports, guides and mentors agripreneurs and agri-startups in agriculture and allied sectors. It serves as the Knowledge Partner for strengthening, handholding and demonstrating best practices among the Agri-Business Incubators (R-ABIs) under the Agri-Innovation and Entrepreneurship Program of PM-RKVY, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India. The Centre has mentored 1,293 agripreneurs and supported 734 startups across 26 States and Union Territories (UTs). The Technology Incubation Centre (TIC) at Guwahati Biotech Park provides an enabling ecosystem for innovators and entrepreneurs to transform scientific ideas into commercially viable technologies and businesses. The Centre offers ready-to-use modular laboratory spaces, specialised scientific facilities, technical infrastructure and support services, reducing the initial infrastructure burden for biotechnology startups and entrepreneurs.

GBP supports entrepreneurs through incubation, mentoring, training, capacity-building programmes and access to specialised research and analytical facilities. Its infrastructure includes facilities for analytical instrumentation, bioprospecting, micropropagation, herbal extraction, fermentation and bioinformatics, among other technology support services. These facilities enable startups and researchers to undertake research, product development, prototype testing and validation. Through its incubation and entrepreneurship initiatives, GBP promotes the development of innovation-led ventures across biotechnology and allied sectors. The Park also facilitates connections between entrepreneurs, research institutions, academia and industry, contributing to the growth of a stronger biotechnology and innovation ecosystem in Assam and the wider North Eastern region. The Park encourages the effective utilisation of the region's rich biodiversity and bio-resources for developing innovative products and technologies. By fostering collaboration and knowledge sharing among key stakeholders, GBP creates opportunities for innovators and entrepreneurs to develop, validate and scale their ventures, supporting sustainable entrepreneurship and technology-driven growth.
