The accelerator experience is a process of intense, rapid, and immersive education aimed at accelerating the life cycle of young innovative companies, compressing years' worth of learning-by-doing into just a few months. Accelerator programs can provide beneficial resources to organizations at all stages of development, most focus on those that are pre-revenue. Through accelerator program, MANAGE-CIA propose to support early stage agri-startups through dedicated mentoring, by connect with network of founders, angel investors, venture capitalist, other experts & administrators, and also supporting them for achieving key milestones like branding, funding, product-market fit etc. The core aim of the accelerator program is to catalyst and support the growth phase of an Agri-startup. The major focus of the program is to give startups platform where they are given dedicated support with focus on growth. The duration of the MANAGE Accelerator program is 12 weeks, and the program will be conducted through online using Webex video conferencing application.

Startups eligibility Criteria (eligibility criteria for the startups):

- Startup should be from Agricultural & allied sectors
- Early-stage startup (1-5 years)
- The solution of the startup should impacts India's economically disadvantaged or solves a problem in the nonprofit ecosystem
- Registered as Partnership Company, Private Limited Company, Limited Liability Partnership or One person Company
- Startup should have launch the product and already in the market
- Gained initial traction for their local market & seek to expand to other areas
- Startup should have already raised money through investment/debt/Grant/Bank loan/Self
- Startup should have core team working full time across all functions of the company
- The startup should have a considerable addressable market size
