Admission in the 9th Batch of PGDAWM Program



India Will Be Having the World's Largest Decentralized Farm Storage Capacity

The warehousing and logistic sector is expected to get a considerable boost from the government. In the budget announcement, the Finance Minister emphasised on India to have the largest decentralized storage capacity in the corporative structure. This will help the farmers store and sell their products at the right time. The plan for the next 5 years is to establish a new multipurpose co-operative societies, primary fisheries society and dairy cooperative societies in every Panchayat.

L&T Finance offers warehouse receipt financing for agri-commodities in 4 states

L&T Finance Limited (LTF), a subsidiary of L&T Finance Holdings Limited, has launched warehouse receipt financing (WRF), a digitally-assisted loan facility against agri commodities. This financing facility will be available in four states Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Gujarat. Currently, these facilities are offered by the market in a traditional manner which is primarily manual in nature and takes anywhere between 7 - 10 days for each loan application to get sanctioned. With the launch of this product, customers can obtain a sanction within 24 hours of filing the loan application and having all the information related to their loans at their fingertips through the mobile application Planet. Farmers, traders and processors can avail this facility at the nearest LTF branch at attractive interest rates for an amount ranging between ₹1 lakh to ₹10 crore. The amount sanctioned will be based on eligibility checks and the loan margin range, which shall be between 25—30 percent of the market value of the commodity, based on quality parameters.

PNB partners with warehousing body to facilitate finance to farmers

The e-NWR financing is considered to be a game changer in shaping the rural economy by preventing distress sale by farmers and helping them in realising better price for their produce. Public sector lender Punjab National Bank (PNB) has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Warehousing Development & Regulatory Authority (WDRA). This will promote financing against Electronic Negotiable Warehousing Receipt (e-NWR). The partnership is aimed to provide information to farmers/depositors of agriculture produce about the benefits of e-NWR besides doing further outreach activities to improve agricultural pledge finance in India. The process is fully digitized and comes with benefits like online marketing, non-issuance of e-NWR above the capacity of warehouse and issuance of e-NWR only when scientific storage norms as stipulated by WDRA are fulfilled. In 2021, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) increased the limit for loans against NWRs from Rs 50 lakh to Rs 75 lakh per borrower. PNB also signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Central Warehousing Corporation to facilitate financing under e-NWR.

Budget 2023: Government to set up massive decentralised storage capacity to help farmers

Union Finance Minister proposed that the government is planning to set up massive decentralised storage capacity to help farmers among other announcements. The agriculture credit target has been increased to Rs 20 lakh crore for Financial Year 2023-24, with a focus on animal husbandry, dairy, and fisheries. The key takeaways for the agriculture sector in Budget 2023 are digital public infrastructure for agriculture built as open source, open standard, and the interoperable public good. Agri accelerator fund will be set up to encourage agri startups in rural areas. In order to enhance yield of extra-long staple cotton, the government will adopt a cluster-based and value-chain approach. Govt to provide Rs 5,300 crore assistance to the drought-prone central region of Karnataka and Government also to support Hyderabad based millet institute as a centre of excellence.
