
100% Final Placements!

The highest CTC offered was 18 lakhs INR/Annum with the average being 7.72 lakhs INR/Annum. The highest number of students moved to the Financial Services (27), the second highest being Agri-input sector (20). Six of the students got placed in Consultancies. The others are Procurement (3), Development (2) and Animal Husbandry (2).
