A historic event of the signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was organised on the eve of February 16th Thursday, 3.00 PM at the NABARD Head Office in Mumbai to facilitate credit flow in AC&ABC scheme. Chandra Shekara, Director General, MANAGE-Hyderabad and Sandeep Chavan, Senior Vice President as well as Ashey Agarwal, Senior Vice President, HDFC, Mumbai. The purpose of signing of MoU is to streamline and facilitate credit flow under





the AC&ABC scheme. After signing of MoU the officials has discussed the strategies to execute MoU for benefit of agripreneurs. The Agri-Clinics and Agri-Business Centres Scheme was launched with the slogan "Better Farming by Every Farmer." Through 45 days of free residential train-

ing on Agripreneurship Development, one-year post-training handholding support, and loan and subsidy provisions, the scheme has transformed unemployed agriculture graduates, diploma holders, and biological science graduates into Agripreneurs. As of today, 84752 Agripreneurs have been trained, with 36601 establishing 32 different types of Agriventures around the country under this scheme. Agripreneurs have shown a favourable impact on farmer yield and income, as well as creating employment opportunities for farmers' sons and daughters in rural areas.MAN-AGE-AC&ABC team will facilitate to identify the contact person from MoU signatories i.e. from NABARD, MAN-AGE, HDFC bank and same will send to Nodal officers in respective states. The MAN-AGE team will conduct monthly review meeting with all contact persons and facilitate loan process for trained candidates under AC&ABC scheme.
