MANAGE INAUGURATES INTERNATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM ON TRANSFORMING AGRICULTURE FOR SMALLHOLDERS THROUGH EFFICIENT MARKETING

MANAGE inaugurated a two-week training program on "Transforming Agriculture for Smallholders through Efficient Marketing" scheduled during 10 – 23 September 2025. The Program is being organised under Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) with the support of the Ministry of External Affairs, GoI. He emphasized that as agricultural officials, the primary responsibility lies in empowering farmers by sensitizing them to new initiatives, technologies, and platforms, which play a vital role in enhancing the incomes of smallholder farmers.
