Academic Highlights....

Besides the administrative and financial items, the EC meeting considered and approved the following academic proposals.

- •MANAGE will allow international participants to attend one day Webinars and online training programs free of charge. However, they need to pay US \$500 as course fee and also pay lodging and boarding charges for physical training programs of 3-5 days duration at MANAGE campus. They also need to pay fee for MOOC-based courses.
- •MANAGE will collaborate with universities abroad for Student Exposure Program on self-finance basis for the students of PGDM (ABM) Program.
- •MANAGE will launch a 45 days self-financed Certificate Program for CEOs of Farmers Producer Organisations


ICICI Bank agreed to provide unsecured educational loans upto Rs. 20.00 Lakhs to students of PGDM (ABM) program of MANAGE.

Webinar on Innovations under ATMA For Enhancing Farmers Income



MANAGE organized an online National Workshop on 'Innovations under ATMA for enhancing Farmers' Income' during 15-16 December 2021. The Workshop was organised to identify, document and disseminate successful innovations and agri-extension strategies by different ATMAs across the country. Further, the challenges faced by the ATMA officials and suggestions to overcome these challenges were elicited. A total of nine thematic areas were selected, based on ATMA

activities, to address the overall objective of the workshop. These areas include: overview of ATMA, opportunities and challenges; innovations in promoting Farmer Organizations/Commodity Interest Groups; promoting Market Led Extension in the district; promotion of Farmer Friend/Agripreneurs/Farm School; Climate Smart Strategies and ICT Applications; Gender Mainstreaming; Innovations in Convergence of institutional efforts; effective implementation of SREP; and promotion of Public Private Partnership (PPP).

Feedback was obtained from the participants to understand their constraints and suggestions for strengthening extension strategies through ATMA. The participants were Block Technology Managers, Assistant Technology Managers, Project Directors, Deputy Project Directors, officials representing KVKs, National and DAESI facilitators etc. The webinar was organised by Dr. Mahantesh Shirur, Deputy Director (Agricultural Extension), MANAGE.

Training on Mobile Journalism (MOJO) Organised

MANAGE, in collaboration with the Electronic Wing, Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University (PJTSAU), organized an innovative online training programme on "Mobile Journalism for effective Transfer of Technology for Extension Officers" from 14-17 December, 2021. A total of 26 selected agricultural extension officers attended the program.

Inaugurating the program, Dr. P. Chandra Shekara, Director General, MANAGE stated that mobile is a powerful tool to disseminate timely agricultural extension and advisory services to the farmers. There is need for Agricultural Extension Professionals and Scientists to acquire skills to produce creative digital content for mobile users with the help of available tools and techniques, he said.

The training focused on advances and practical steps in Mobile Journalism (MOJO) for effective transfer of agricultural technology, audio journalism, video



journalism, script writing and video editing on smart phones, photo journalism, mobile story telling etc., through practical demonstrations and short assignments to participants.
