Message from Director General




MANAGE is playing a key role in promoting two important programs of Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Gol. One is popularizing the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund and its benefits to prospective Agripreneurs, Agri Startups and MSMEs and the other one is creating nationwide awareness on Natural Farming.

The Telangana State Level Conclave on Agriculture Infrastructure Fund was organised at NIMSME, Hyderabad on July 8, 2022. It was attended by more than 400 prospective MSMEs, Agripreneurs, and Agri-Startups to explore opportunities under the scheme. Sh. Samuel Praveen Kumar, JS (Extn, AIF & I& PS), MA&FW, GoI, explained the features of Agriculture Infrastructure Fund and the process for applying for loans under the scheme.

MANAGE has been identified as Nodal Organization and Knowledge Repository on Natural Farming by Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, Gol. I am very glad to inform that MANAGE has so far organised 924 Awareness Programs covering 54,547 Gram Pradhans in all the States in the country with the support of SAMETIS, ATARIS, KVKs, and ATMAS from April to July 2022. MANAGE also developed more than 360 Master Trainers on Natural Farming in the country who can build capacities of stakeholders.

I am happy to share that two PGDM(ABM) students were selected in the "Godrej Loud" season 11 competition held by Godrej Agrovet Limited, a major Agri-Business Giant in the country. Under this, each student will get Rs. 1,70000 summer internship and PPOs with a CTC of 20 Lakhs per year.

In July 2022, MANAGE signed MoUs with National Coalition for Natural Farming-Revitalizing Rainfed Agriculture (RRA) Network, Hyderabad and Indian Agribusiness Systems Limited (AgriWatch), New Delhi to collaborate with them in the areas of natural farming and FPOs outreach to national and international markets. We, at MANAGE, believe that such partnerships would bring synergy to address emerging needs in agriculture.

Samuel Praveen Kumar, JS (Extn, AIF & I & PS), MA & FW, Dr. P. Chandra Shekara, DG MANAGE, Dr Glory Swarupa, DG NIMSME, Shri. Hanumant, IAS Spl Commissioner Agriculture, Sri K. Ramulu, VC & MD, TSAGROS, and senior bank officials.

It was attended by more than 400 prospective MSMEs, Agripreneurs, and Agri-Startups to explore opportunities under the scheme.

The features of the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund and the process for applying for loans under it were emphasised by Sh. Samuel Praveen Kumar, JS (Extn, AIF & I& PS), MA&FW, GoI. He also discussed how the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund interacts with other subsidies, programmes, and top-up features. He also highlighted Telangana state's enormous potential and encouraged qualified organisations to take use of the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund finance infrastructure development. He emphasised the value of agricultural automation and mechanisation, particularly drones, as well as the help offered through the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund to provide job prospects for young people in rural areas.

In order to build primary processing infrastructure for the major crops cultivated in Telangana, such as cotton and paddy, Sri K. Ramulu, VC & MD, TSAGROS, Govt. of Telangana urged that the qualified organisations apply for Agriculture Infrastructure Fund support.

Speaking at the Telangana State Level Conclave on the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund, Dr. S. Glory Swarupa, Director General, NIMSME, offered assistance to MSME in order to maximise the advantages of the program.

Dr. P. Chandra Shekhara, Director General of MANAGE Hyderabad, highlighted that the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund is a fantastic opportunity for Agripreneurs, Input Dealers, Agri-Startups, and MSMEs to expand their business horizons in Telangana State and capitalise on the potential.

The Agriculture Infrastructure Fund programme was presented in detail by Sh. Y Krishna Rao, CGM, NABARD, who also emphasised the MoU between Manage Hyd, SBI, and NABARD that guaranteed financial aid for Telangana candidates under the AC&ABC scheme.



five states in Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Odisha and Sikkim and trained more than 360 Master Trainers on Natural Farming.

MANAGE is also responsible to organize Awareness Programs on Natural Farming to Gram Phadhans in India. Nodal Organization and Knowledge to target of 30,000 Gram Pradhans were successfully trained by MANAGE through 750 programmes by July 3rd, 2022. 

MANAGE PGDM(ABM) Students Win Godrej Loud Competition

Godrej Agrovet Limited, a major Agri-Business Giant, holds the "Godrej Loud" competition every year, which is open to everyone in India. On July 11th, 2022, season 11 (the eleventh year of competitive events) officially began.

The event attracted about 2500 students from the top 15 B-Schools (only top IIMs, including IIM A, IIM B, XIMB, and MANAGE, are allowed to participate). 40 students were chosen from the preliminary competitive events to compete in the final round, which was held on August 2 and 3 at the Godrej headquarters in Mumbai. Six of the 40 students who were shortlisted came from MANAGE. Two MANAGE students were chosen in the final round for the sales and marketing roles.

The benefits for these students include the following. Each of them will receive Rs. 170000 summer internship offer depending on how well



they perform throughout their summer internship, PPOs with a CTC of 20 Lakhs per year will be made available. In contrast to last year, when only one student was chosen, this year, two first-year students were chosen. The students were able to win the prestigious fellowships thanks to the exceptional coaching provided to them in areas like case presentation and GD abilities.
