



Training at MANAGE

Need-based Training Programs

MANAGE imparts need-based training on select thematic areas to agricultural extension functionaries working in State Departments of Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Fisheries, Sericulture, Scientists of State Agricultural Universities as well as Executives in the private sector. Training Programs, Workshop, Seminars, Conferences, Dialogues, Webinars are organized on key areas of current importance to prepare the extension functionaries to cope with new challenges and for effective implementation of various Flagship Programs of Governments. MANAGE also organizes customized training programs in response to the requests from the Govt. of India, State Governments & UTs, Organizations, Universities and Private Sector Companies.

MANAGE imparts training to senior and middle level Officers in India and also offers training to Senior Executives of Asia and African countries through bi-lateral and multi-lateral Agreements through Govt. of India.

Training Methodology

MANAGE's training programs are farmer-focused and user-friendly. The strength of MANAGE training programs is based in participatory and experiential learning methodology. It includes case studies, success stories, hands-on practice, field visits, group work, soft skills, communication skills, interactive sessions, discussions, presentations by participants, technical sessions by MANAGE faculty and experts drawn from pioneering Institutions in India. MANAGE believes in problem-solving approach to field level issues faced by farmers, officers and other stakeholders in its training programs.

Who can attend

Agricultural Extension functionaries working in State Departments of Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Fisheries, Sericulture, Scientists and Academia from Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR Institutions), State Agricultural Universities, Faculty of State Agricultural Management and Training Institutions (SAMETIs) and Extension Education Institutions (EElS) in the country can attend MANAGE online or off-line training programs.

MANAGE also encourages Innovative Farmers, Agripreneurs, Input Dealers, Agri Startups, NGOs, Private Sector, FPOs, Research Scholars, Students of Agricultural Universities etc. They may attend online training programs and webinars of MANAGE for free. However, MANAGE will permit highly suitable and serious candidates from this group to attend physical or off-line training programs.

How to Register

MANAGE gives details (title of the training program, scheduled dates, venue, name of the course director and a link for online registration) of all training programs on its website www.manage.gov.in two months ahead of the scheduled time. Those who are interested to attend a training program may register through an online registration form mentioned against that program. The eligible candidates will receive confirmation from the concerned course director.

Program Schedule

Usually, MANAGE will follow the schedule as mentioned in the Training Calendar. But however, due to unavoidable circumstances sometimes the dates of training programs may be rescheduled. Hence, it suggested to check MANAGE website www.manage.gov.in for exact dates of the training programs or contact concerned MANAGE Faculty Members.

Fee

National Participants

There is no course fee for Government Functionaries to attend online or off-line training programs. For the training program in physical mode / off-line, the nominating Government Department / Organization has to bear the Travelling and Dearness Allowance (TA &DA) of their nominees. MANAGE will not pay any TA or DA to participants. MANAGE will provide free lodge and boarding arrangement during the training period at its hostel. MANAGE has limited accommodation facilities at its hostels and guesthouse. Therefore, participants are discouraged to bring accompanies or spouses along with them.

International Participants

International participants may attend Online Training Programs and Webinars free of charge. However, for physical / off-line programs of 3 or 5 days duration, MANAGE charges an amount of US \$500 towards course fee, lodging and boarding charges. Suitable accommodation will be provided at MANAGE hostel. The air travel, visa and any other expenses should be borne by the candidate or the sponsoring organization. The International participants should send their nominations through the Government official channels to MANAGE well in advance for processing and confirmation

Consultancy-based Training Programs

MANAGE organizes training programs on consultancy basis on the request from State Departments, Agricultural Universities, NGOs, FPOs, Private Agri Business Companies.

MANAGE also undertakes highly tailor-made capacity development programs, skill development programs, MDPs and project-specific programs for Executives of Private Sector, Project Managers and Faculty Members of Agricultural Universities and Induction Training Programs for newly recruited officers of State Departments on consultancy basis. MANAGE may be contacted indicating specific training requirement for a detailed proposal with budget estimate.
